


# Eluding Impound Number

## The Question

- What is entered for the impound number when vehicle is indicated as impounded?

## Comments

- After submission it is routed to MAIU. Any available evidence (in-car camera, BWC, PODS, GPS, etc) is examined.

The impound number field is reserved for future use. There is no specific number to be referenced in this field.

Currently, as of this writing, any character can be entered to fulfill validation, such as a "period", the letters "TBD", or even a RD#.

AutoDesk updates information in HotDesk and they utilize that field.
