Online Privacy

Data brokers regularly sell private information. Even if you have an online privacy service companies "delete" your information as a one-time service, next week/month your information will pop back up from another data broker. To keep your information reasonably off the internet, continual monitoring is the only solution.

You can definitely remove the information by yourself, but understand you'll have to fill out online forms for each data broker. You're looking at approximately 50 data brokers for a reasonable result.
